How do I register?

Registrations and payments for Minnesota CLE webcasts are processed solely online. If you haven't done so already, you will first need to create your free Minnesota CLE login account. This process is quick and easy. Simply go to www.minncle.org and click **LOGIN**. Proceed through the pages to create your login account. Once logged in, click any webcast title on the seminar roster for additional course information or to register. Once registered, you will receive an e-mail confirmation notice that includes complete instructions for viewing the webcast.

How do webcasts work?

Webcasts can be viewed on a computer using your web browser and Windows Media Player. You will find a complete list of system requirements on our website at www.minncle.org. Please check your system compatibility before you register for any live webcast. On the day of the webcast a link to join the webcast will appear on our homepage (www.minncle.org) shortly before the start of the program. You must be logged in to see this link. Simply click the link to join the live webcast. You'll see and hear the seminar, and will be able to e-mail questions to the presenter.

You will be able to download, print, and review the written materials (if any) prior to the webcast. If materials are available, a link to download them will become active on Minnesota CLE's homepage at www.minncle.org one day before the webcast. You may need Adobe Reader to view and print the materials. Adobe Reader is available for free at <http://get.adobe.com/reader/>
