Michael J. Burke practiced law for 25 years in Howell, Michigan. On June 18, 2001, he was sentenced to three to ten years in prison and ordered to pay \$1.6 million in restitution to his client-victims. He is a compulsive gambler. After spending 32 months in prison, he began traveling extensively, giving presentations on compulsive gambling. He is the author of *Never Enough: One Lawyer's True Story of How He Gambled His Career Away*, published by the American Bar Association.
