**ORDER DIRECTING PERSONAL
REPRESENTATIVE TO PAY CLAIM**

The Petition for an Order Directing Personal Representative to Pay Claim, signed by _____, came before this Court on _____. The Court, having heard and considered the Petition, determines the following:

1. The Petition is complete.
2. Any notice required by Minnesota law has been given.
3. The Petitioner has declared or affirmed that the representations contained in the Petition are true and complete to the best of the Petitioner's knowledge or belief.
4. The Petitioner is an interested person as defined by Minnesota law because Petitioner has a claim against the Estate. Petitioner's claim has been allowed but remains unpaid.
5. On _____, the four months' statutory period from the date of the first publication of notice to creditors of the Estate expired and the one month period from the date of service on all known and identified creditors has expired. The claim has been allowed but remains unpaid. A Written Statement of Claim has been filed with the Court or a copy of the Written Statement of Claim accompanies this Petition.
6. The Personal Representative should pay the claim of Petitioner, to the extent that funds of the Estate are available.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The Petition is granted.
2. The Personal Representative is directed to pay the claim of Petitioner to the extent that funds of the Estate are available as provided in Minnesota Statutes sections 524.3-807(a) and 524.3-805, as amended.
