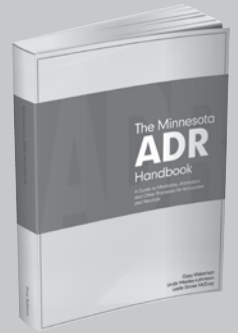

CREDITS

This skills training course is certified for **30 hours of mediation classroom training** by the Supreme Court's Office of Continuing Education, required by Rule 114.12 to provide mediation, med-arb and mini-trial services. Thus, it meets the requirements for inclusion on the statewide qualified neutrals roster civil facilitative/hybrid processes (mediation) roster. Minnesota CLE also has applied to the Minnesota State Board of Continuing Legal Education for **30 hours CLE credit (includes 1 hour ethics credit and 1 hour elimination of bias credit)**.

SCHEDULE

Each day our faculty focuses on different aspects of mediation. This highly interactive course also includes role-playing and observation of mediations. By coaching mediators through mock mediations our instructors help you put mediation theory into practice.
